TIPS for a Successful Field Internship

Agency support is critical to ensure that you are able to meet the requirements for field and your responsibilities as an employee!

- ✓ Speak with your supervisor about your intention to apply to or begin the Intensive Weekend Program.
- ✓ Discuss possibilities to flex your hours, educational leave, or partial reassignment of duties. Plan how you will you structure your time to manage school and your job. Some day-time hours for field are necessary!
- ✓ Explore the possibility of an internship within your agency.



Workplace-based placement

Your agency agrees to provide you with an internship at your place of employment:

- Are there opportunities for field that differ from your current job responsibilities?
- ☐ Is there an MSW available for field instruction who is not your supervisor?
- ☐ How will you separate your field hours from your work responsibilities?



Placement in another agency

To ensure success...

- Determine time you have available and explore the possibility of flexing your work schedule to allow for some day time hours.
- Research possible agencies in your area and explore placement options with agency colleagues and your supervisor.
- Contact only agencies with whom you or your employer have a professional relationship.
