

The Violence Against Women Continuing Education Clinical Work Certificate Program (8 days; 40 hours)

Participants must take 6 required workshops:

1. Understanding Violence Against Women (Foundation workshop)
2. Screening, Assessment, and Basic Intervention Skills (Foundation workshop)
3. Confidentiality and Counseling Ethics *(Previously an Advanced Required workshop)
4. Violence Against Women and Trauma
5. Clinical Presentations of Survivors
6. Treatment of Adult Survivors of Child Sexual Abuse

Participants must select 2 additional workshops from the list of approved Clinical electives:

1. Special Topics in Counseling Ethics and Violence Against Women
2. Counseling with Children Experiencing Sexual Abuse
3. Counseling with Children Exposed to Domestic Violence
4. Special Topics: Working with Perpetrators of Domestic Violence
5. Assessing for Violence Against Women in Family Therapy and Couple's Counseling
6. Working with Women who use Force
7. Special Topics: Violence Against Women and Depression
8. Special Topics: Violence Against Women and Anxiety Disorders
9. Special Topics: Violence Against Women and Eating Disorders
10. Group Counseling with Survivors (*Previously an Advanced certificate workshop)
