Introduction

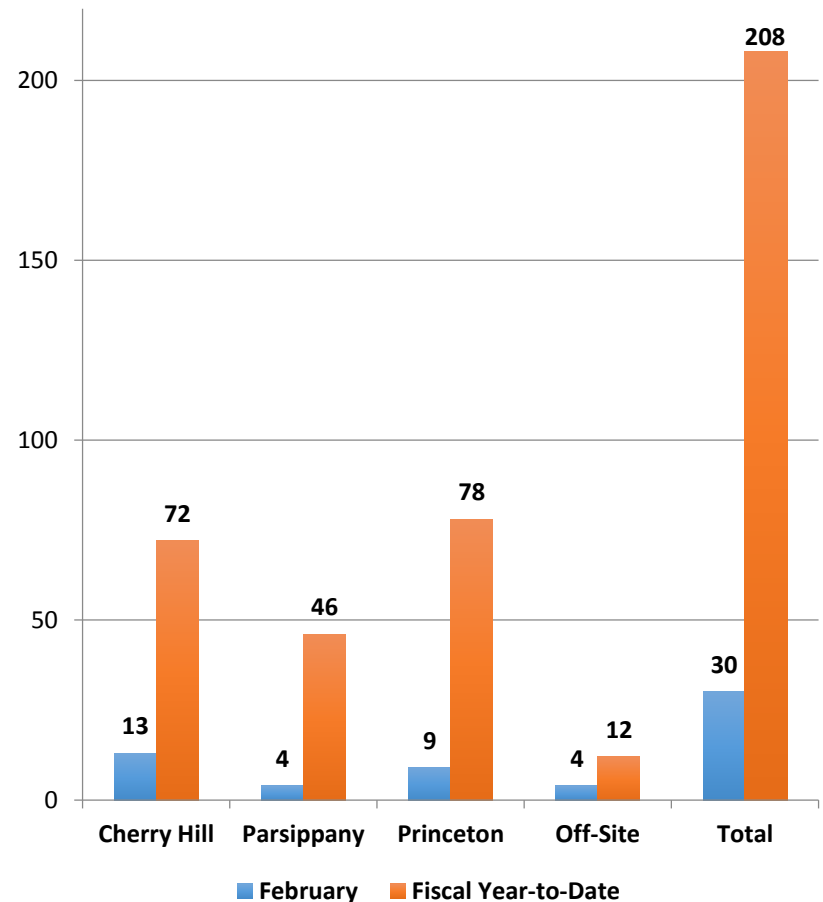
- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

Introduction (continued)

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).

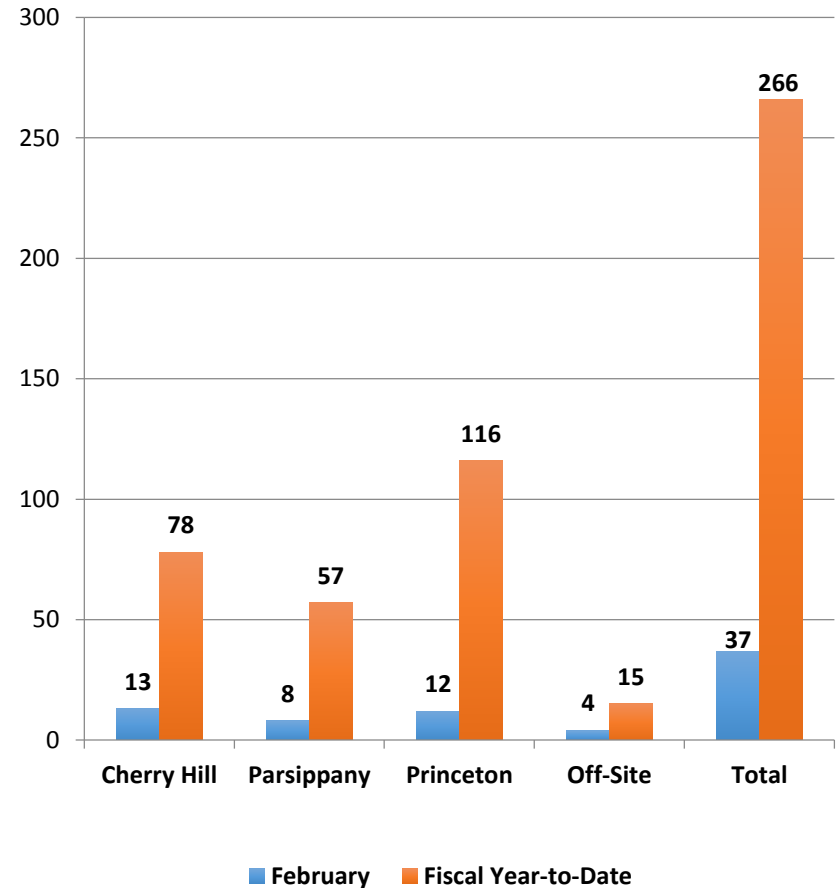
Courses Delivered

- 30 courses were delivered in February, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 208
- 26 courses were offered at NJCSI sites; 4 were offered at an off-site location



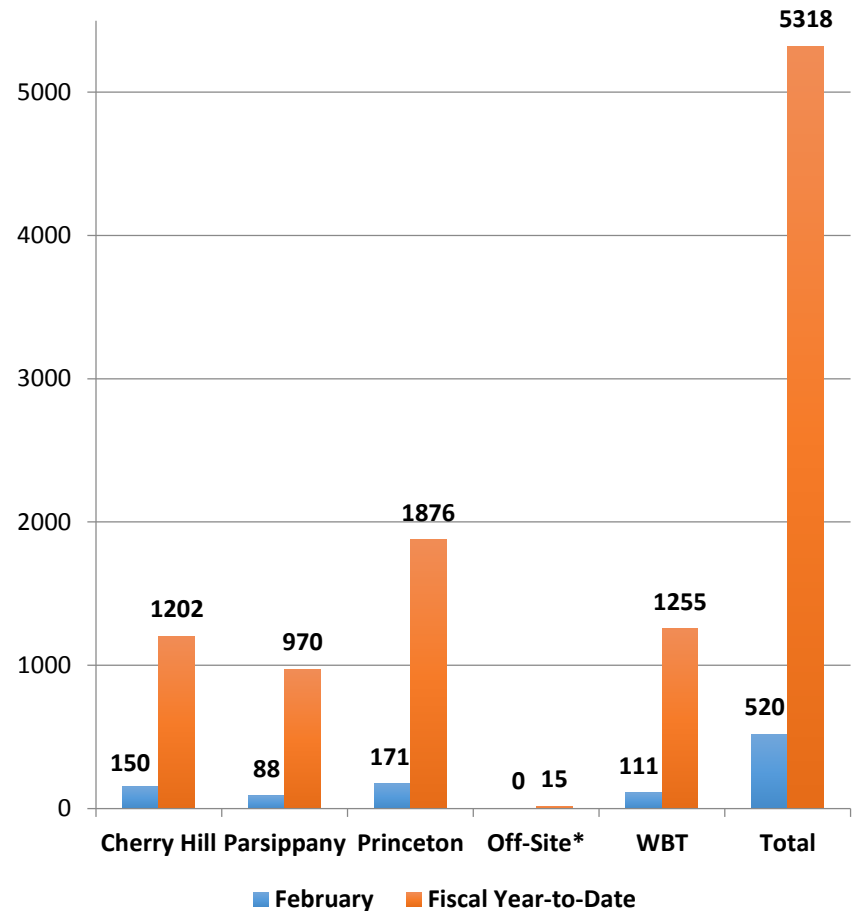
Training Days

- 37 training days were delivered in February, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 266
- 33 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites; 4 training days were delivered at an off-site location



Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)

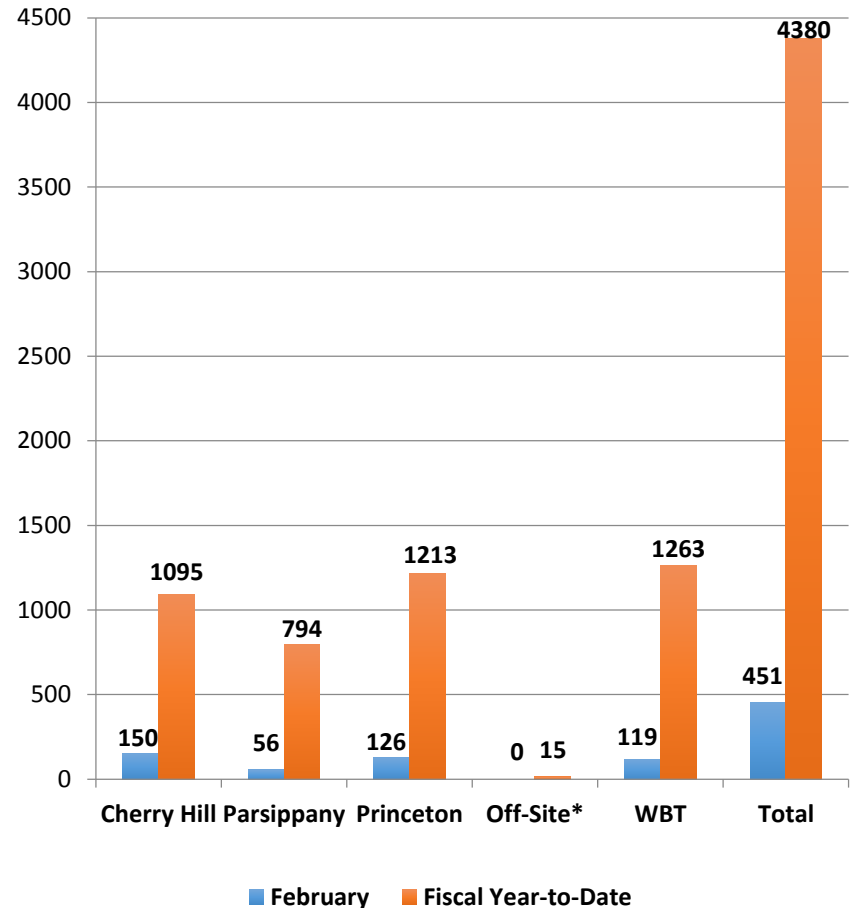
- 520 duplicated participants attended courses in February, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 5,318
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.

Training Participants (Unique Participants)

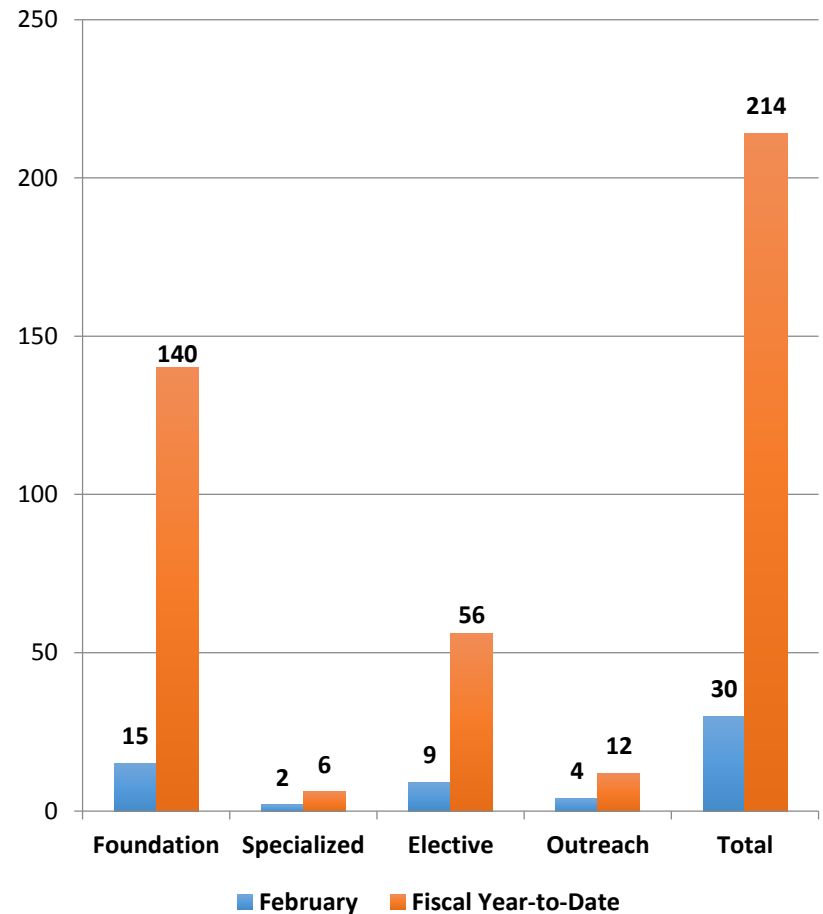
- 451 unique participants attended courses in February, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 4,380
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants. Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.

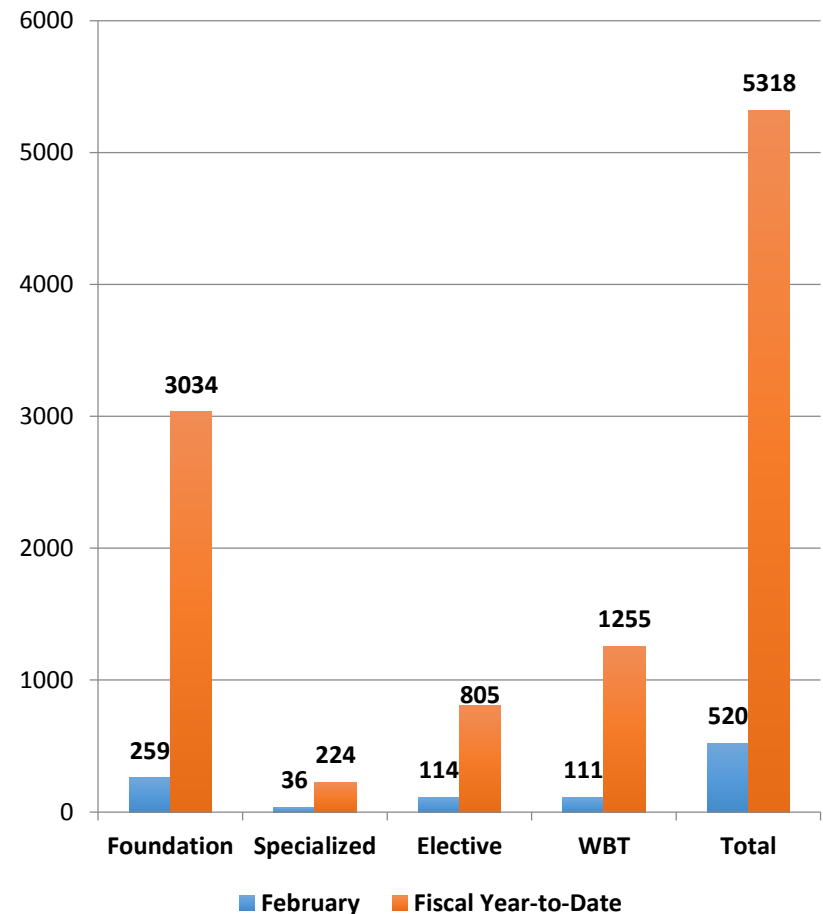
Courses Delivered by Type

- Courses delivered in February included 15 foundation courses, 2 specialized courses, 9 elective courses, and 4 outreach courses (four Stellarware–New Jersey Employer Services Trainings).



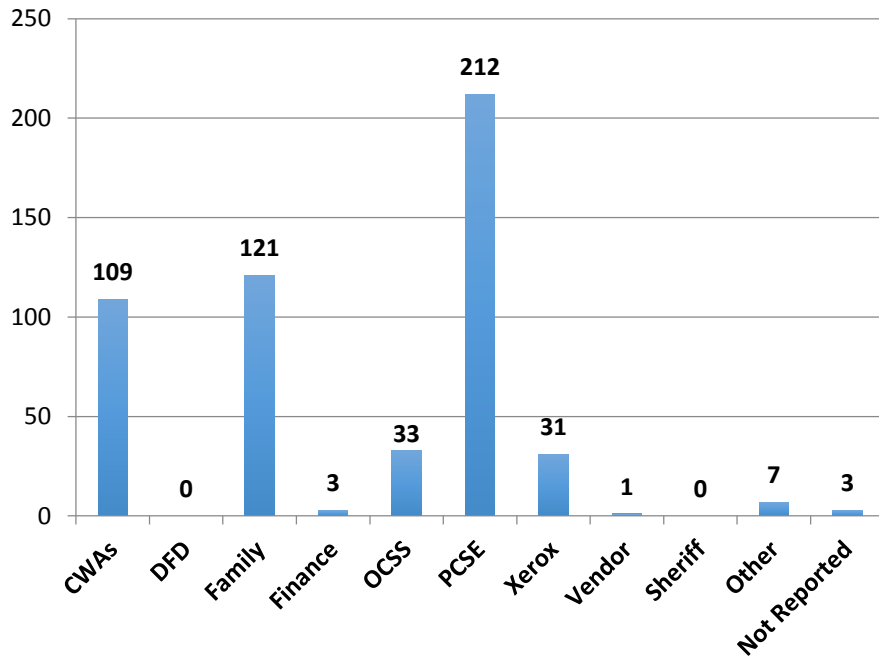
Duplicated Participants by Course Type

- In February, 259 participants attended foundation courses, 36 attended specialized courses, 114 attended elective courses, and 111 completed a WBT.
- To date, 3,034 participants have attended foundation courses, 224 have attended specialized courses, 805 have attended elective courses, and 1,255 have completed a WBT.

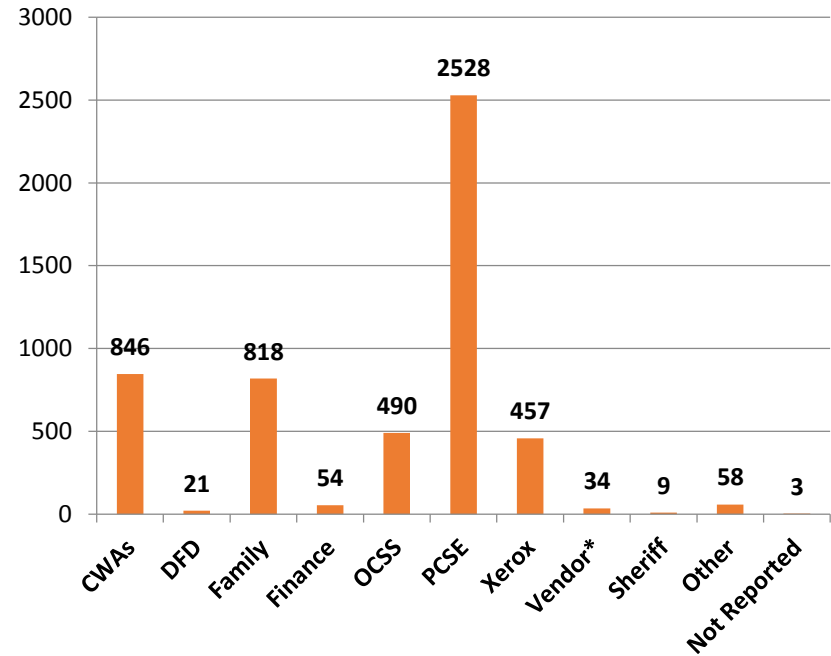


Duplicated Participants by Agency

- 41% of the February trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 212), and approximately 23% were from the Family Division (n = 121)
- From July through February, 48% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 2,528), and approximately 16% were from the CWAs (n = 846).
