# Introduction

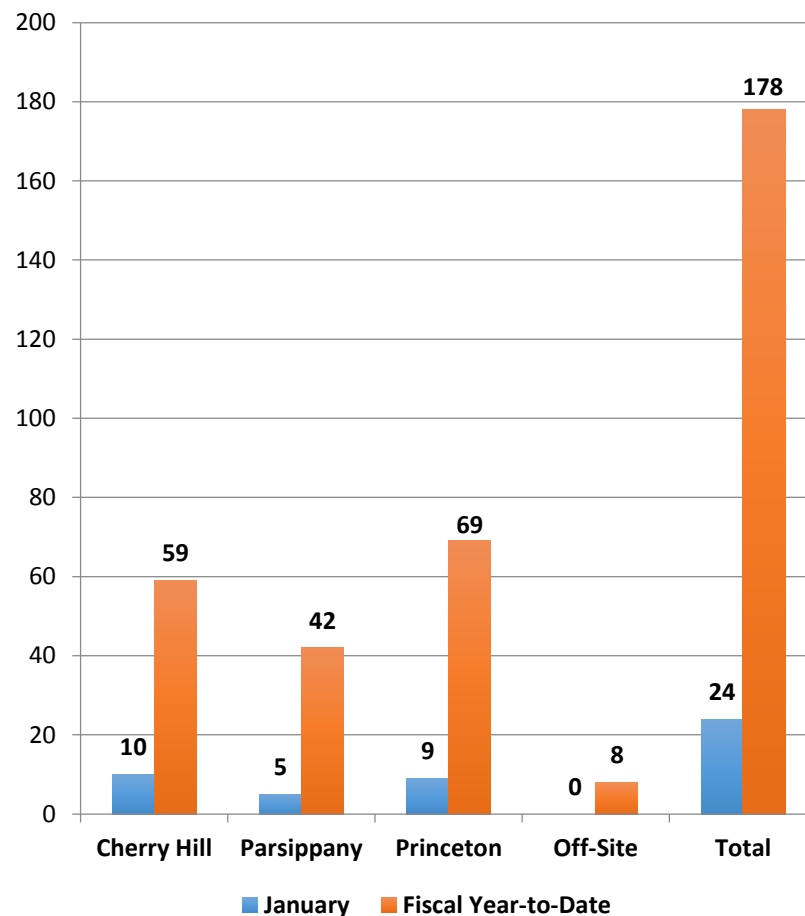
- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).

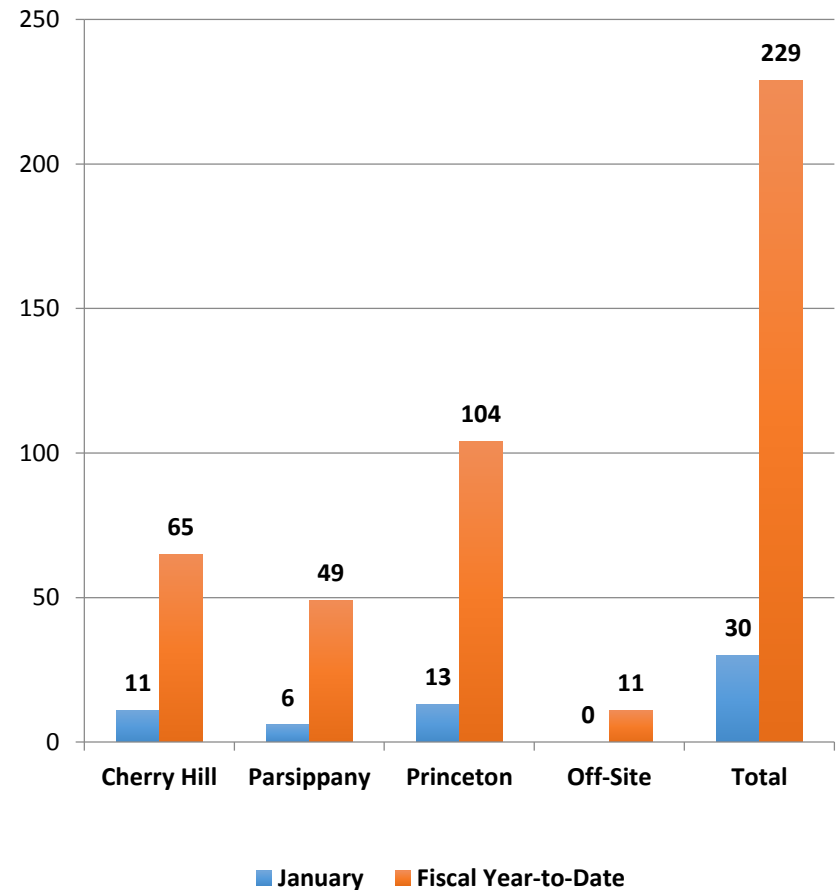
# Courses Delivered

- 24 courses were delivered in January, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 178
- All courses were offered at NJCSI sites.



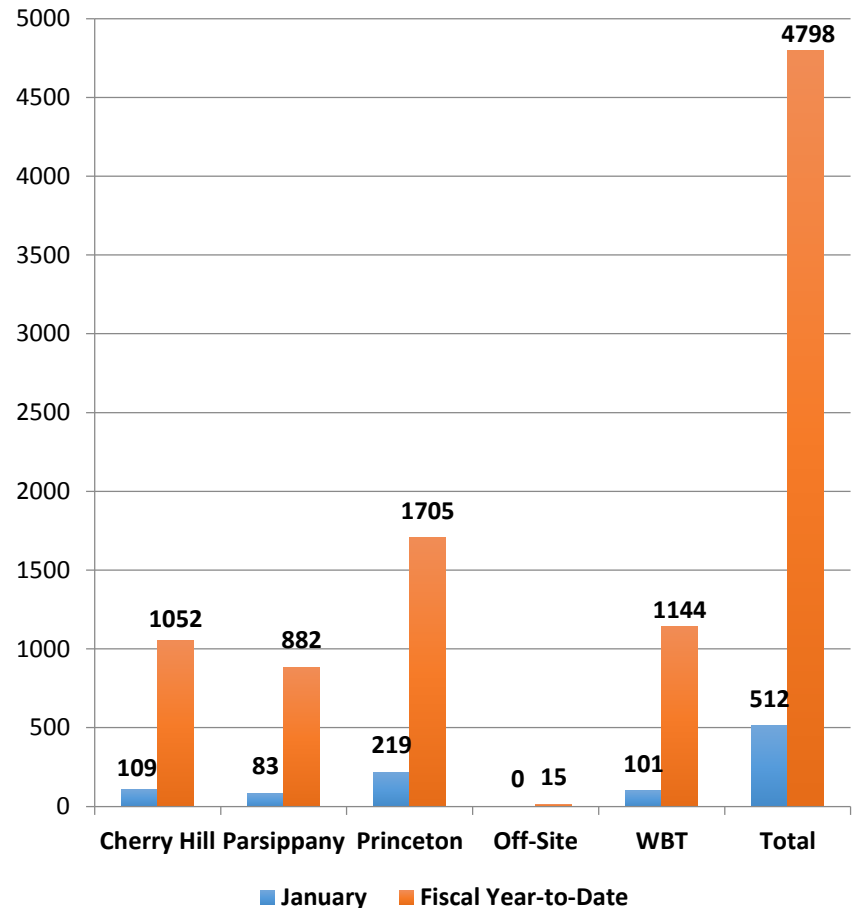
# Training Days

- 30 training days were delivered in January, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 229
- 30 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites



# Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)

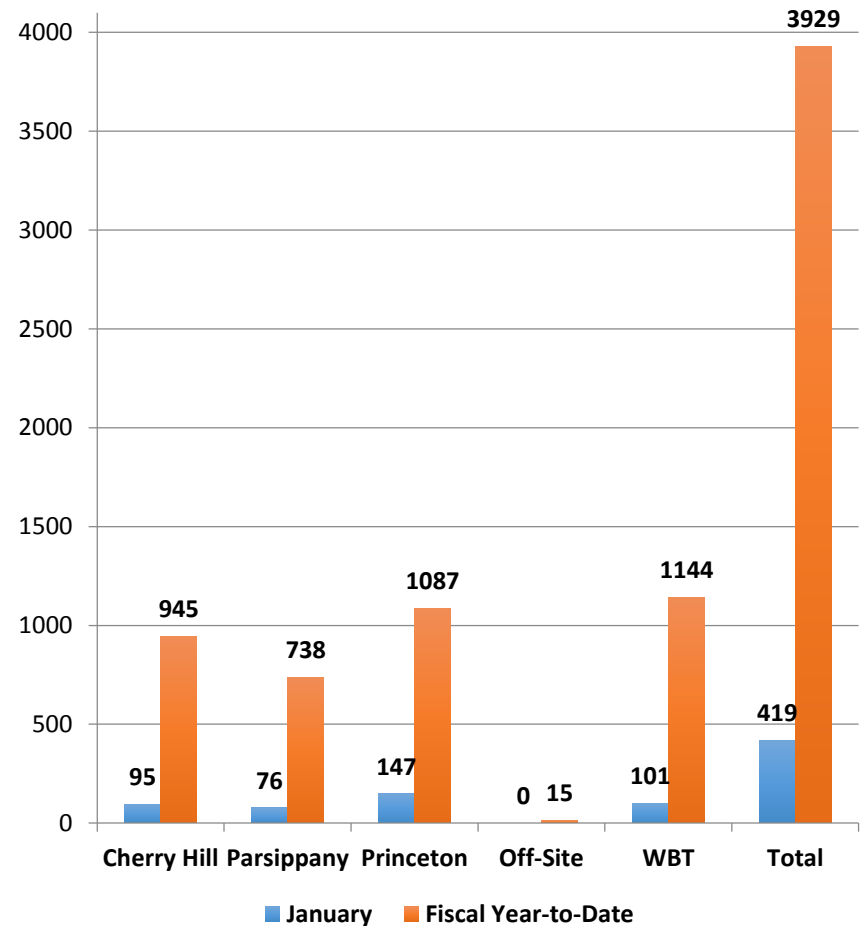
- 512 duplicated participants attended courses in January, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 4,798
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.

# Training Participants (Unique Participants)

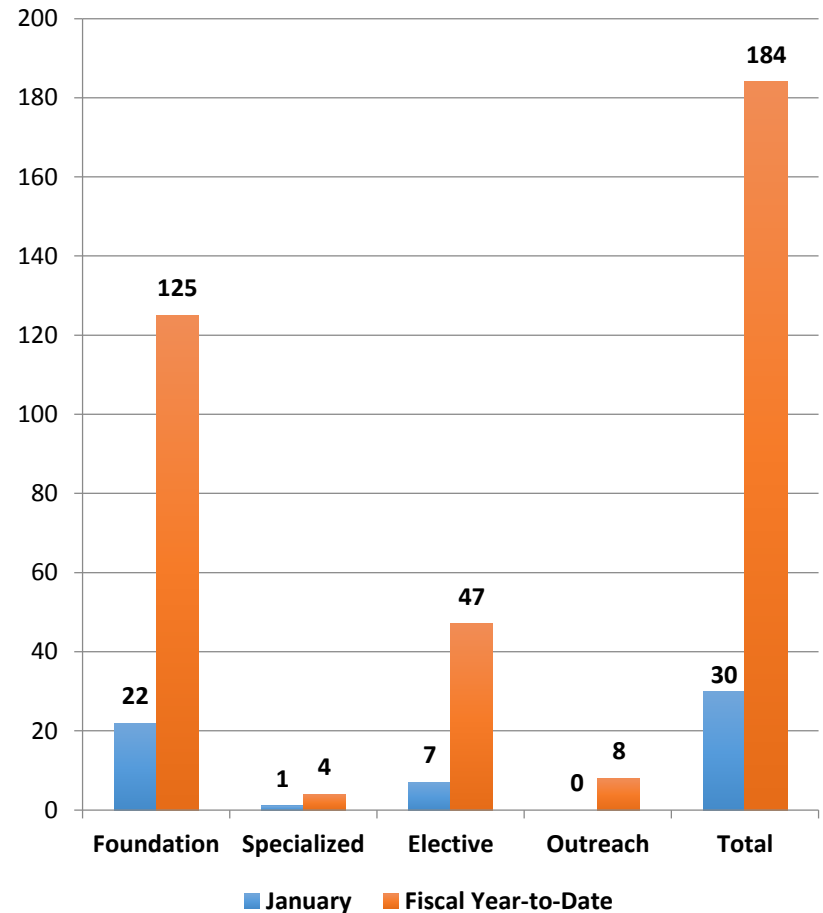
- 419 unique participants attended courses in January, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 3,929
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants. Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.

# Courses Delivered by Type

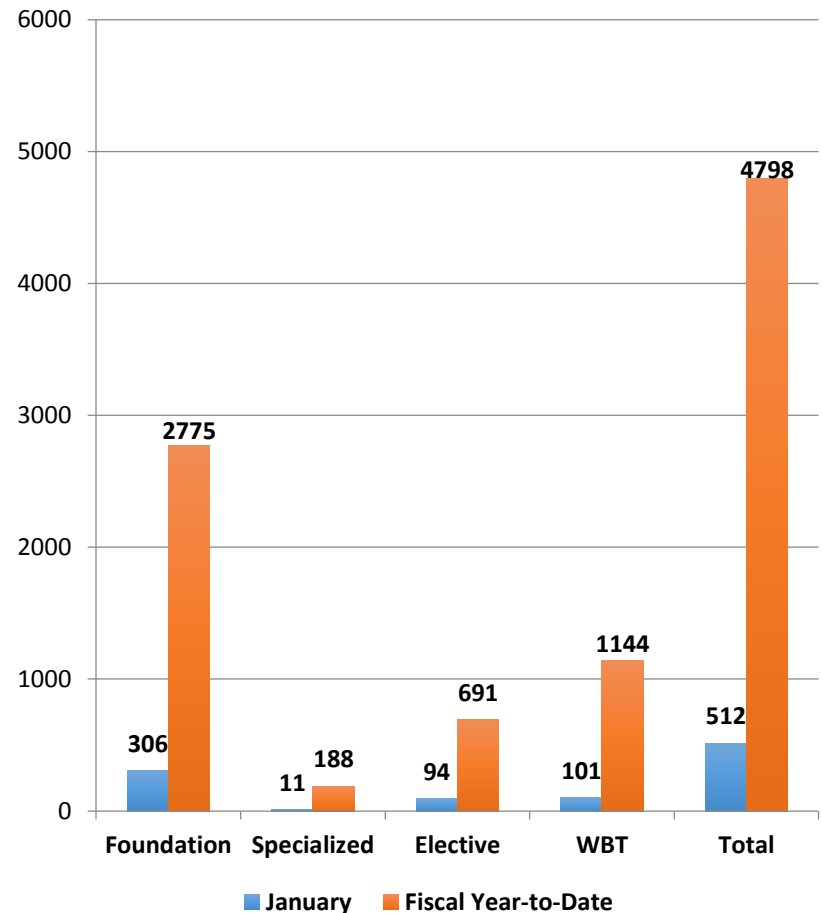
- Courses delivered in January included 22 foundation courses, 1 specialized course, and 7 elective courses.



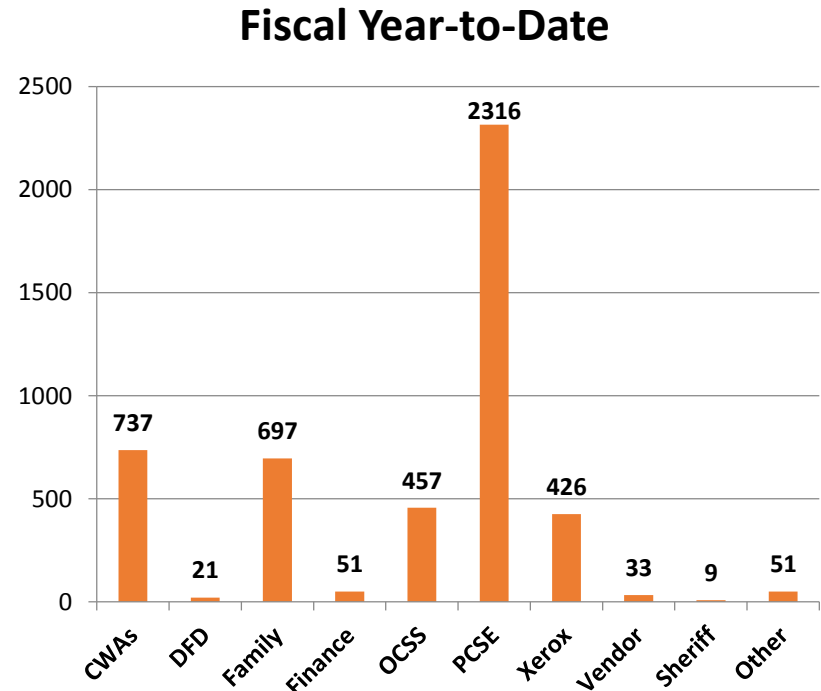
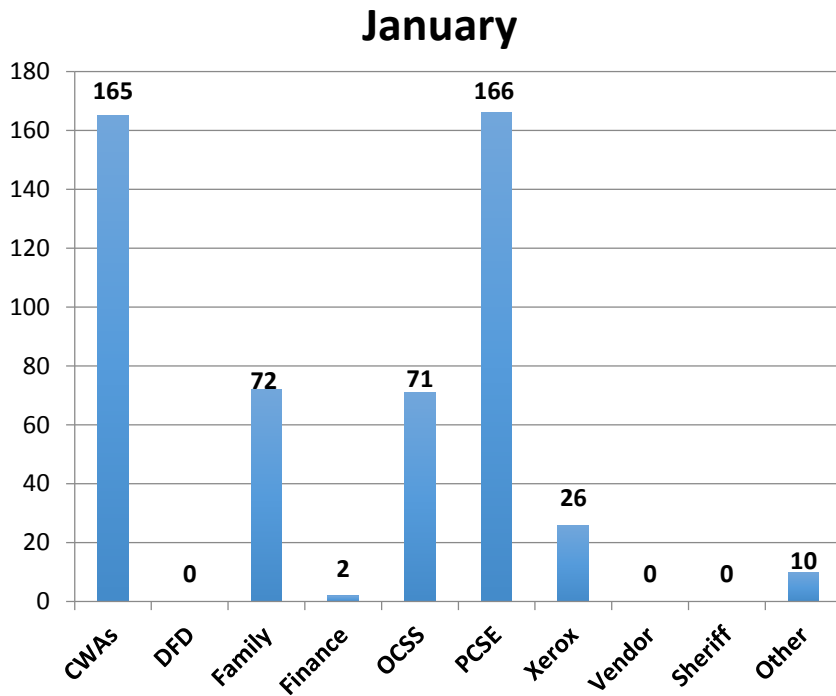


# Duplicated Participants by Course Type

- In January, 306 participants attended foundation courses, 11 attended specialized courses, 94 attended elective courses, and 101 completed a WBT.
- To date, 2,775 participants have attended foundation courses, 188 have attended specialized courses, 691 have attended elective courses, and 1,144 have completed a WBT.



# Duplicated Participants by Agency

- 32% of the January trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 166), and 32% were from the CWAs (n = 165)
- From July through January, 48% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 2,316), and approximately 15% were from the CWAs (n = 737).
