Field Education Curricular Requirements

Students in the 100% Online Advanced Standing MSW program complete 885 hours of field work during the program. The schedule for Fall start is:

Courses must be taken in the above sequence and field hours must be completed in the above sequence. Only after successful completion of the generalist courses, generalist field hours and the statistics requirement, can students begin the specialized curriculum. **Field placements cannot be provided for evening and weekends only. It is the responsibility of the student to have the hours available to do the field practicum. Monday – Friday during the business day (9-5).** There may be placements that offer some weekend and evening hours, but this cannot be guaranteed.

100% Online Advanced Standing Curriculum

The specialized curriculum consists of a specialization in a method of advanced clinical practice, an advanced research course, advanced field instruction, and electives. Our current online advanced curriculum offers a specialization in clinical social work.

Specialization in Clinical Social Work

The specialization in Clinical Social Work prepares students to conceptualize, provide, and supervise the delivery of social work services to individuals, couples, families, and small groups. Emphasis is on developing competence in those helping processes used to prevent problems and to enhance, develop, and restore social functioning. Courses required for the specialization and which must be taken concurrently with a clinical social work field education practicum are:
