

ACT Course Sequencing

[514] HBSE: Understanding Addictive Behaviors

- Prerequisites: [502] HBSE or [898] Clinical Specialization or [899] MAP Specialization
- Must be taken first
- Offered in Winter, Spring and Summer
- May coincide with [598] Case Management – Summer

[598] Case Management in Addictions Practice

- Prerequisite/Co-Requisite: [514] HBSE: Understanding Addictive Behaviors
- Offered in Summer and Fall
- May coincide with [514] HBSE: Understanding Addictive Behaviors – Summer
- May coincide with [522] CSW: Addictive Behaviors I – Fall

[522] Clinical Social Work: Addictive Behaviors I

- Prerequisite: ([514] HBSE: Understanding Addictive Behaviors/HBSE: Addictive Behaviors Across the Lifespan or [571] HBSE: Understanding Addictive Behaviors) and [898] Clinical Specialization
- Offered in Fall
- May coincide with [598] Case Management - Fall

[597] Clinical Social Work: Addictive Behaviors II

- Prerequisite: [522] Clinical Social Work: Addictive Behaviors I
- Offered in Spring
- May coincide with [510] Gambling Counseling and Special Topics and [599] Professional Development - Spring

[510] Gambling Counseling and Special Topics

- Prerequisite: [522] Clinical Social Work: Addictive Behaviors I
- Offered in Spring
- May coincide with [597] CSW Addictive Behaviors II and [599] Professional Development - Spring

[599] Professional Development and Responsibility in Addictions Practice

- Prerequisite: [522] Clinical Social Work: Addictive Behaviors I
- Should be taken last
- Offered in Spring
- May coincide with [597] CSW Addictive Behaviors II and [510] Gambling Counseling and Special Topics – Spring
