<p>Loan Repayment Programs (LRP)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is NOT a research grant • Postdocs or higher rank • You must be actively engaged in independent or mentored research to qualify 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible student loans • \$50,000 annually up to \$200,000 (if awarded a 2-year LRP award and a 2-year renewal) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NIH Division of Loan Repayment
<p>F31 (Individual National Research Service Award – NRSA)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Predoctoral fellows • Provides predocs with supervised research training in health-related areas leading toward a research degree (e.g., PhD) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certain aspects of the degree program (e.g., dissertation research) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NIH – F31
<p>F32 (Individual National Research Service Award – NRSA)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Postdoctoral fellows • Provides postdoctoral research training to individuals to extend their potential for research in specified health-related areas 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Postdoctoral training 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NIH – F32
