Statement of Scholarship

My research focuses on two areas: (1) understanding addiction risk factors and harms among consumers, especially for people from high-risk groups and health disparity populations; and (2) improving the addiction treatment system by examining treatment access and outcome predictors experienced by racially minoritized consumers and underserved communities. I translate findings to academics, policymakers, providers and the public. My research has been published¹ across interdisciplinary outlets and regularly involves student authors. Through my scholarship, I have earned awards and fellowships from NIDA and the Fulbright Program, and been Principal Investigator, Co-PI, or Co-I on projects supported by SAMHSA, Department of Health and Human Services, and university pilot funds. I teach and lead courses on addiction, mentor student research, deliver clinical trainings, and provide national, community and university service. My scholarship is informed by growing up in a disadvantaged rural area (NIH-defined) with limited health care access.
