Introduction


- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).


Courses Delivered

- 26 courses were delivered in August, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 52
- 23 courses were offered at NJCSI sites;
 3 were offered at an off-site location




Training Days

- 29 training days were delivered in August, bringing the year-todate total to 60
- 26 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites; 3 training days were delivered at an off-site location



Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)


- 527 duplicated

Training Participants (Unique Participants)


- 464 unique

Courses Delivered by Type




Duplicated Participants by Course Type


- In August, 339

 participants attended
 foundation courses, 152
 attended elective
 courses, and 36
 completed a WBT.
- To date, 855 participants have attended foundation courses, 9 have attended specialized courses, 214 have attended elective courses, and 75 have completed a WBT.



Duplicated Participants by Agency





- 40% of the August trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 211), and approximately 36% were from the Family Division (n = 187)
- From July through August, 47% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 542), and approximately 21% were from the Family Division (n = 240).
