# Introduction

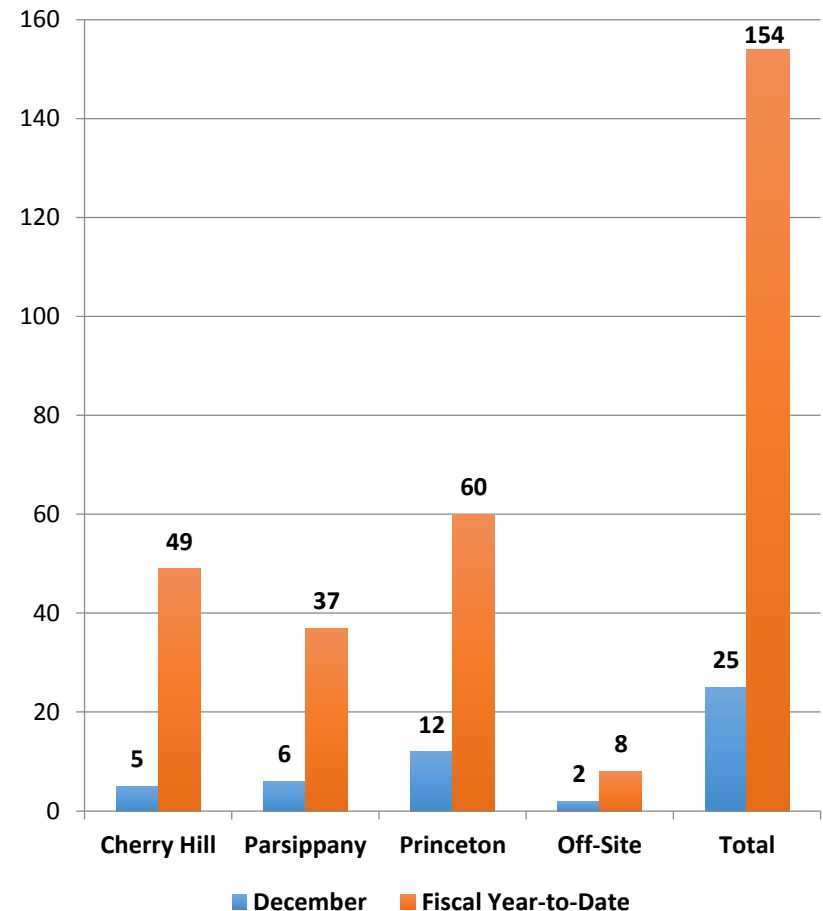
- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).

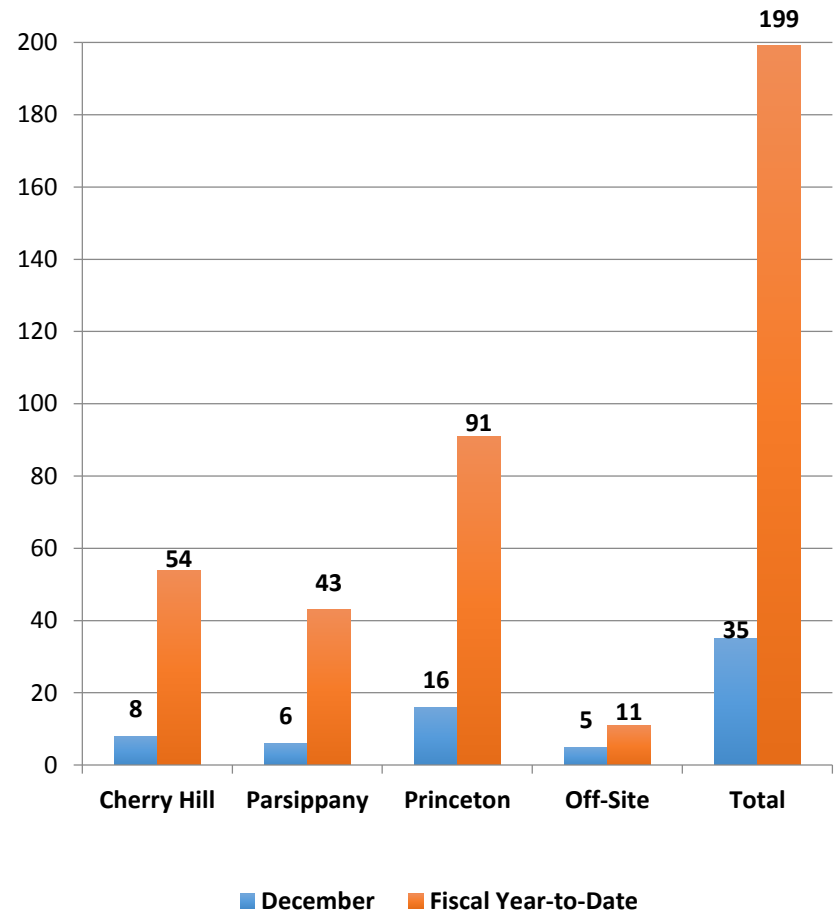
# Courses Delivered

- 25 courses were delivered in December, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 154
- 23 courses were offered at NJCSI sites; 2 were offered at an off-site location



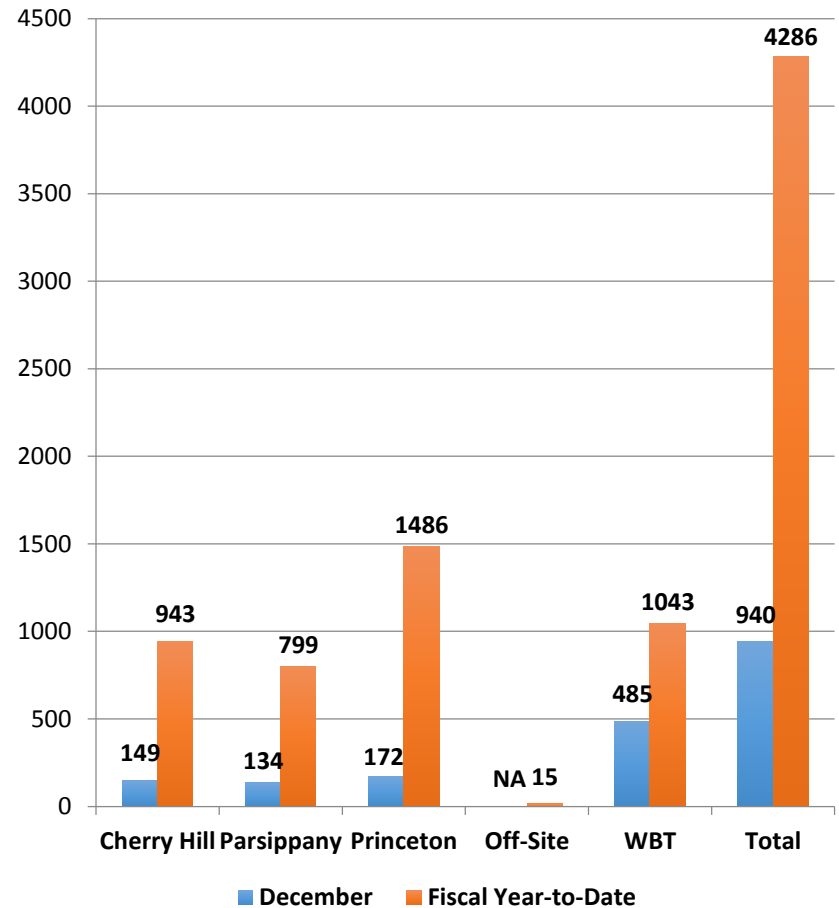
# Training Days

- 35 training days were delivered in December, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 199
- 30 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites; 5 training days were delivered at an off-site location



# Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)

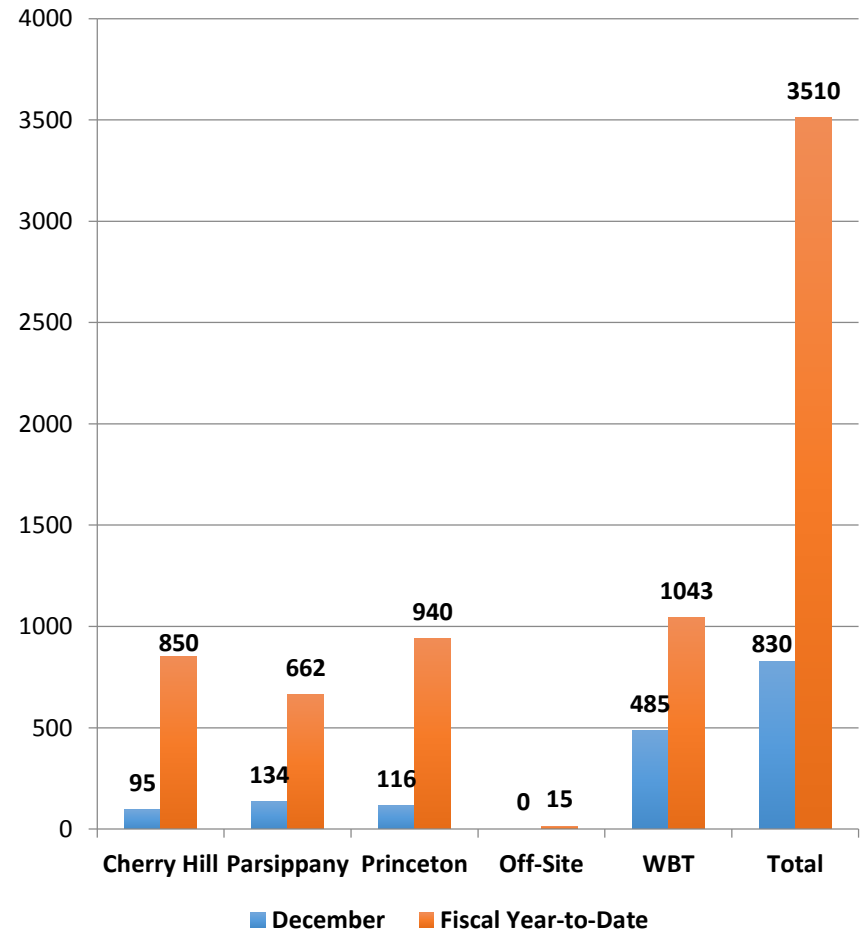
- 940 duplicated participants attended courses in December, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 4,286
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.

# Training Participants (Unique Participants)

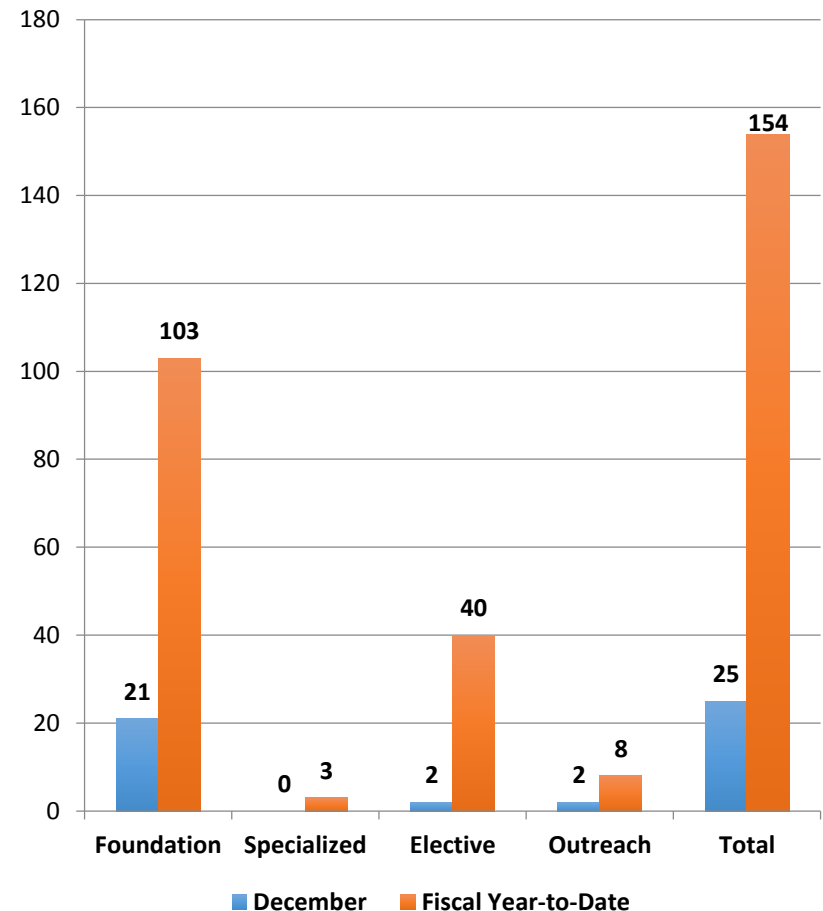
- 830 unique participants attended courses in December, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 3,510
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants. Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.

# Courses Delivered by Type

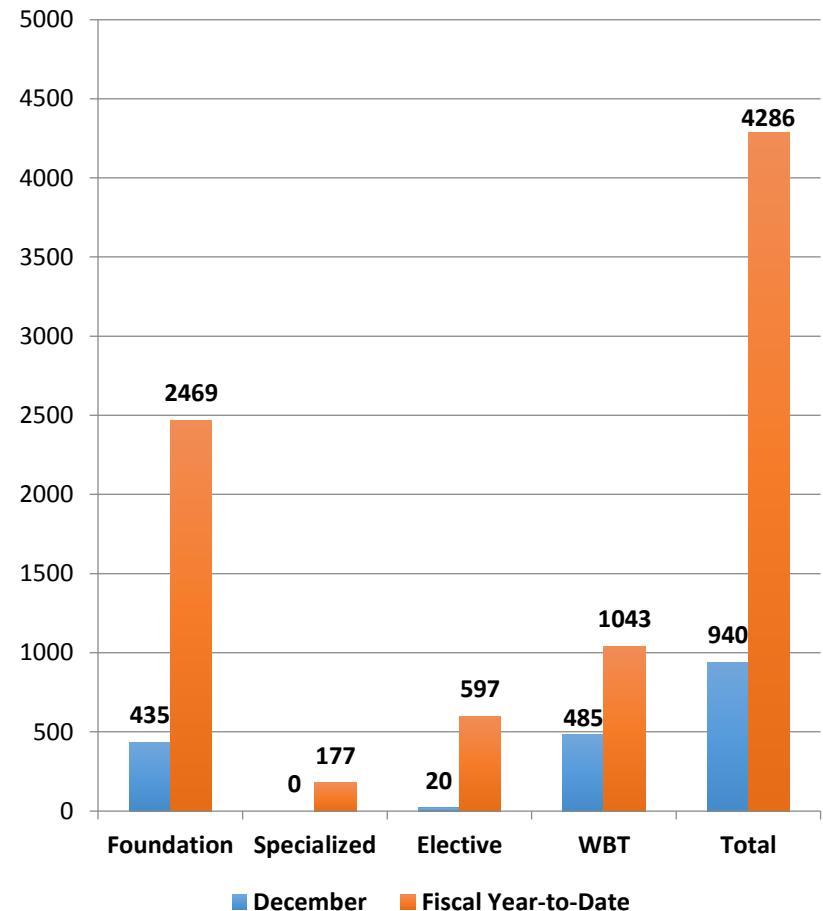
- Courses delivered in December included 21 foundation courses, 2 elective courses, and 2 outreach courses (Fatherhood Symposium and Stellarware–New Jersey Employer Services Training).





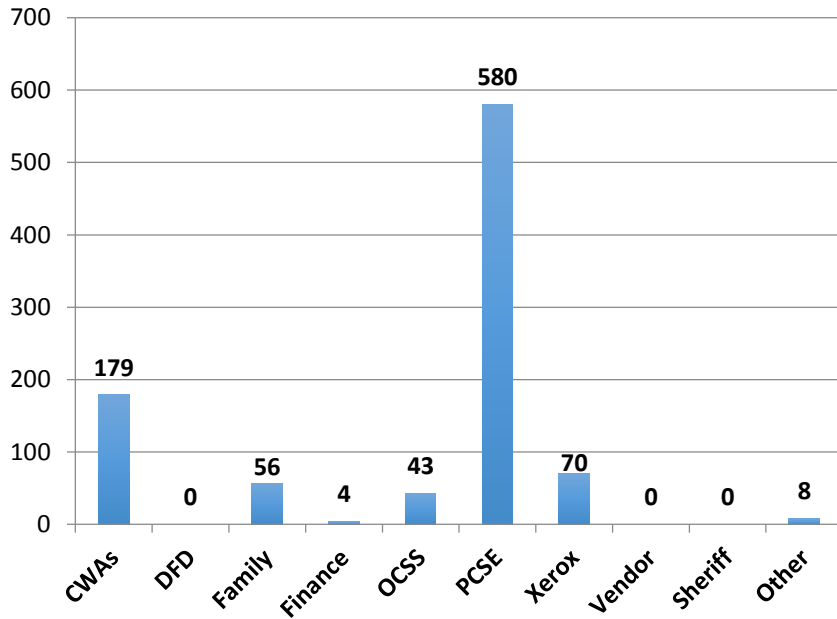
# Duplicated Participants by Course Type

- In December, 435 participants attended foundation courses, 20 attended elective courses, and 485 completed a WBT.
- To date, 2,469 participants have attended foundation courses, 177 have attended specialized courses, 597 have attended elective courses, and 1,043 have completed a WBT.

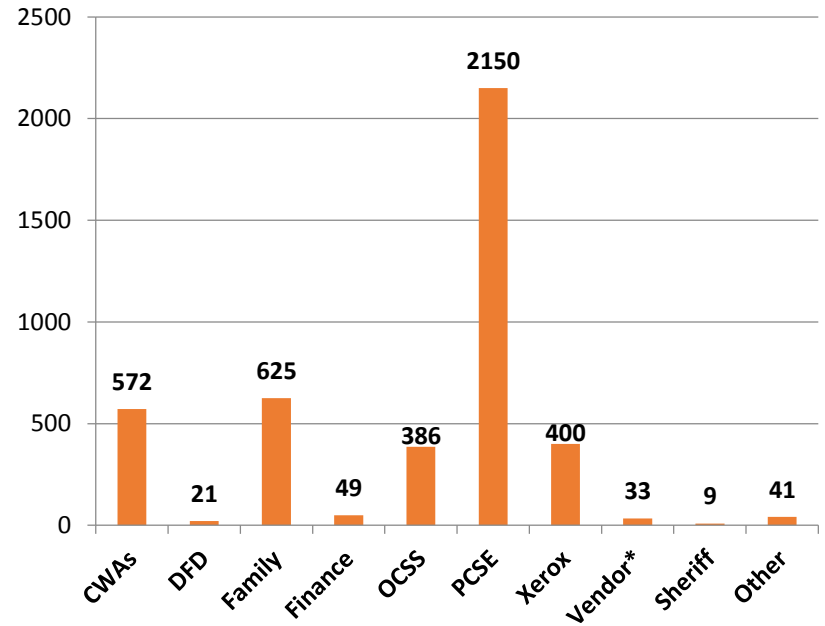


# Duplicated Participants by Agency

- 62% of the December trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 580), and approximately 19% were from the CWAs (n = 179)
- From July through December, 50% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 2,150), and approximately 15% were from the Family Division (n = 625).
