Introduction


- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

Introduction (continued)

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016). Because this report shows data for only the first month of the fiscal year, the fiscal year data are equal to the July data.


Courses Delivered

- 25 courses were offered at NJCSI sites; 1 course was offered at an off-site location




Training Days

Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)


- 626 duplicated participants attended courses in July

Training Participants (Unique Participants)


- 508 unique participants attended courses in July

Courses Delivered by Type




Duplicated Participants by Course Type
