Introduction

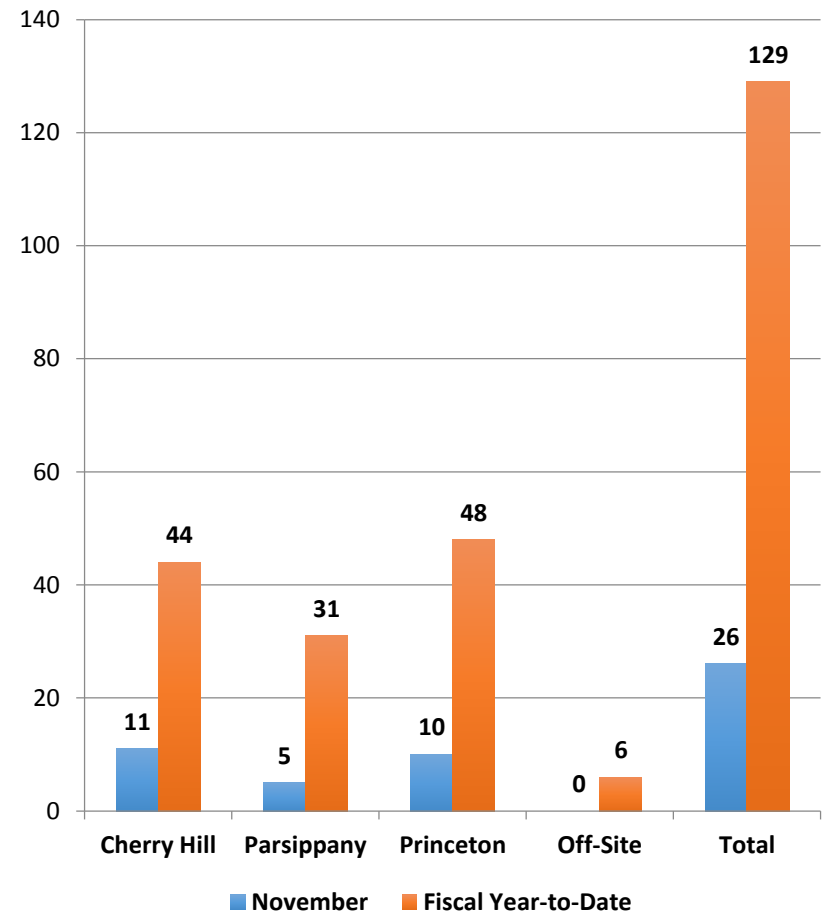
- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

Introduction (continued)

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).

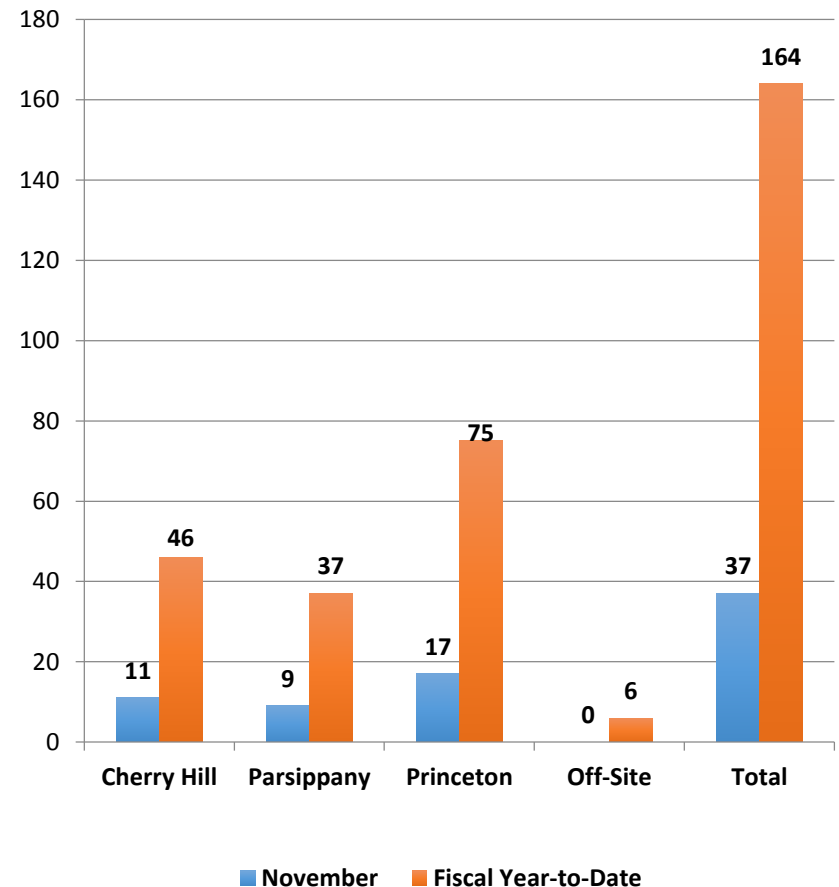
Courses Delivered

- 26 courses were delivered in November, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 129
- All courses were offered at NJCSI sites.



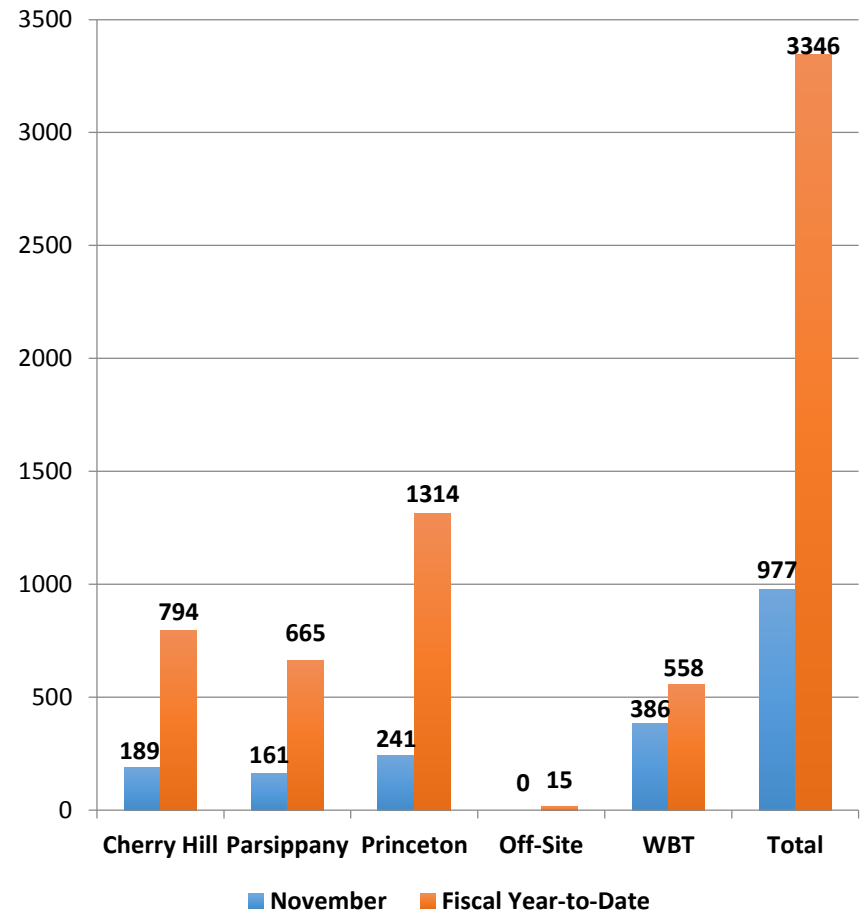
Training Days

- 37 training days were delivered in November, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 164
- 37 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites.



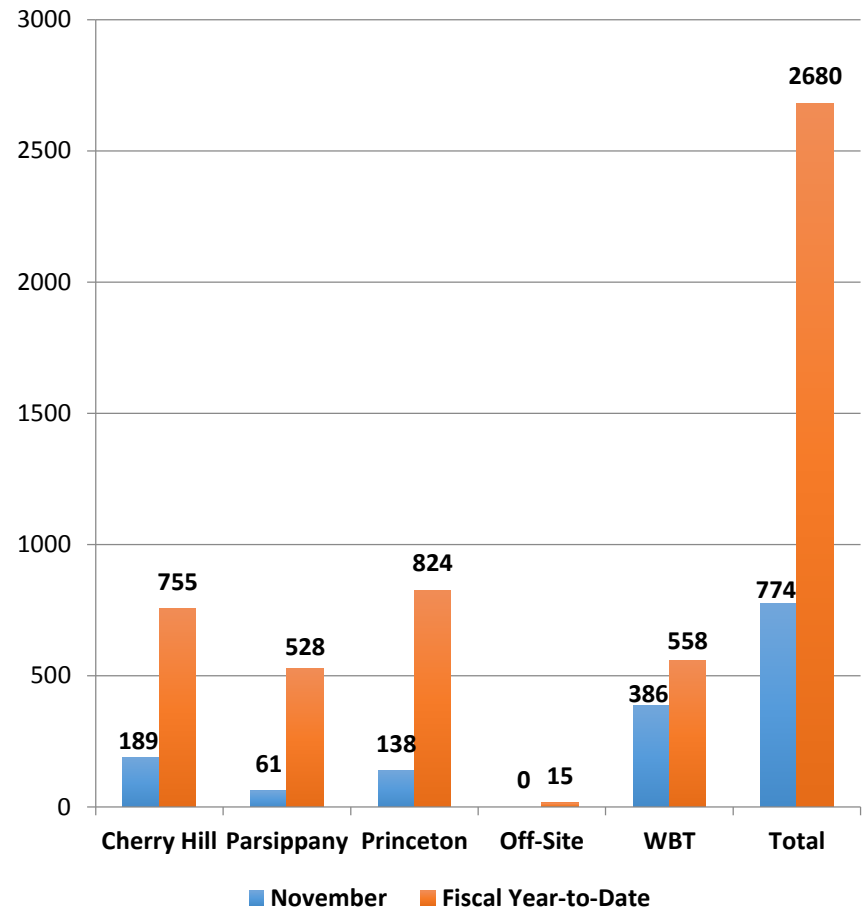
Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)

- 977 duplicated participants attended courses in November, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 3,346
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.



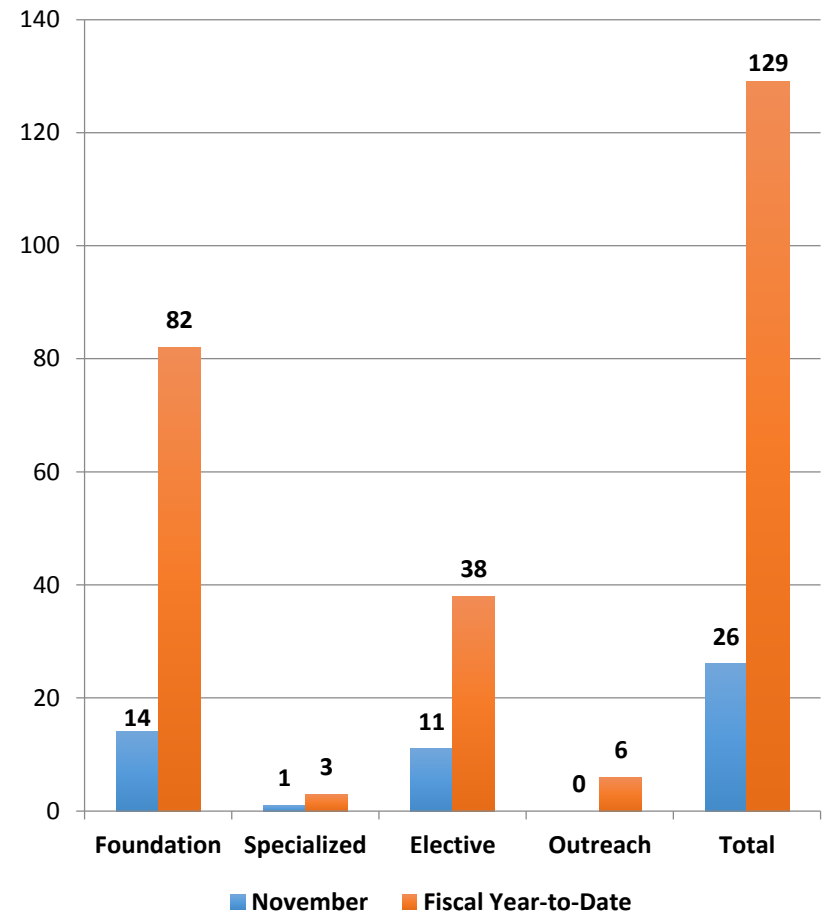
Training Participants (Unique Participants)

- 774 unique participants attended courses in November, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 2,680
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants. Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.



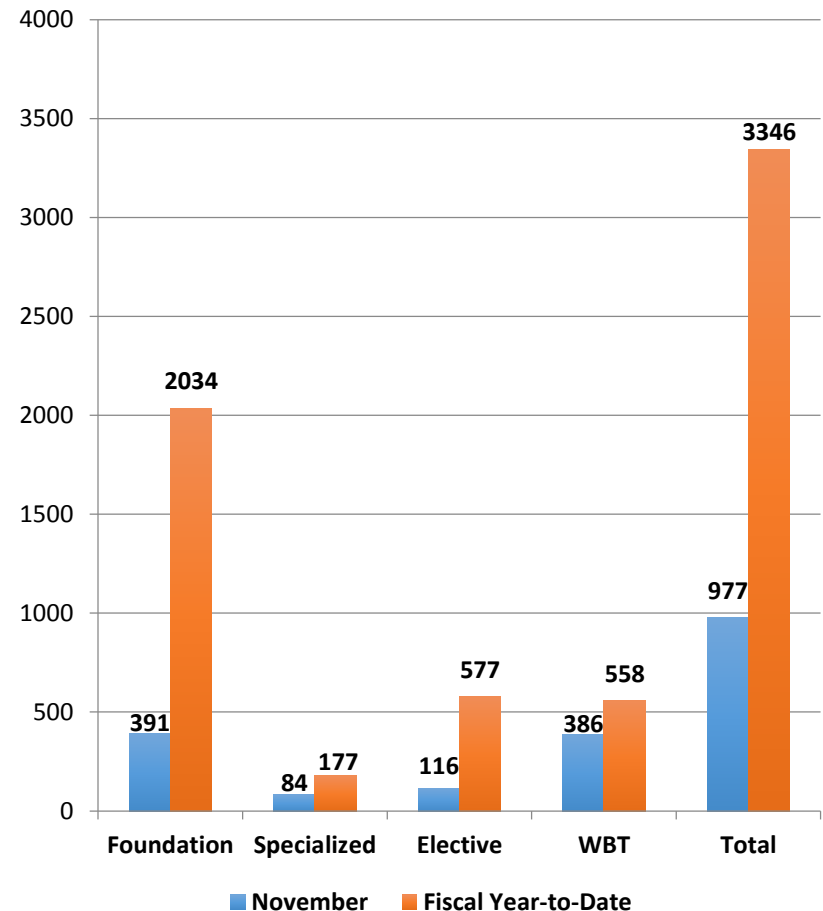
Courses Delivered by Type

- Courses delivered in November included 14 foundation courses, 1 specialized course, and 11 elective courses.



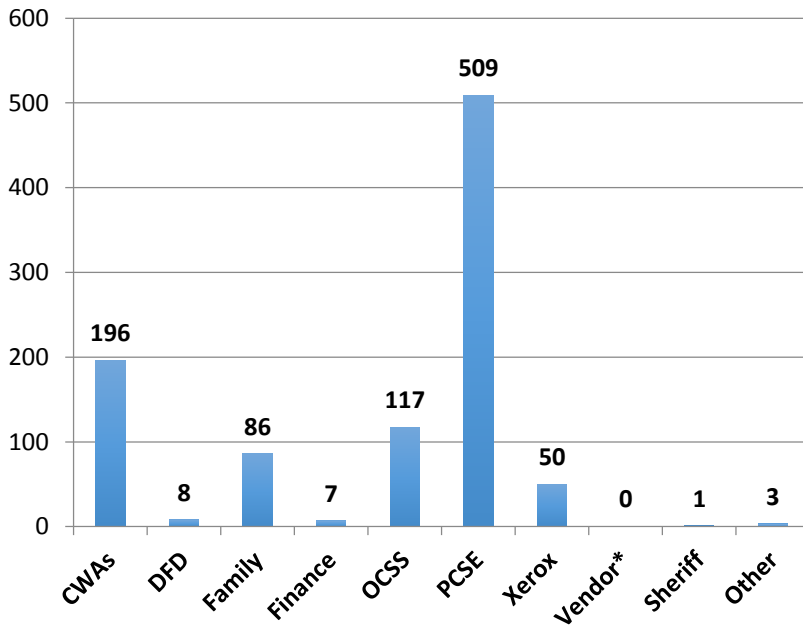
Duplicated Participants by Course Type

- In November, 391 participants attended foundation courses, 84 attended specialized courses, 116 attended elective courses, and 386 completed a WBT.
- To date, 2,034 participants have attended foundation courses, 177 have attended specialized courses, 577 have attended elective courses, and 558 have completed a WBT.

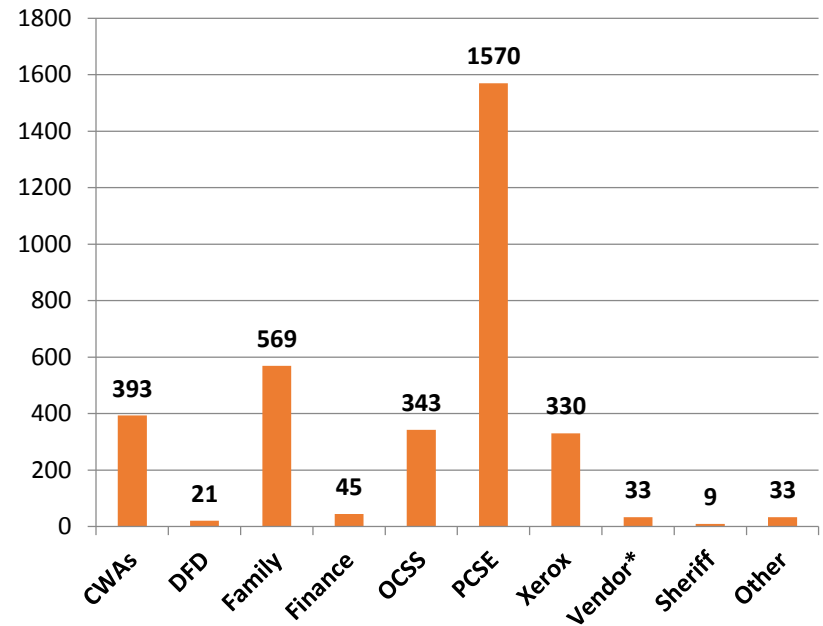


Duplicated Participants by Agency

Fiscal Year-to-Date



- 52% of the November trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 509), and approximately 20% were from the CWAs (n = 196)
- From July through November, 47% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 1,570), and approximately 17% were from the Family Division (n = 569).
