Introduction


- NJCSI offers comprehensive training programs designed specifically for the professionals employed in New Jersey's Child Support Program.
- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.

Introduction (continued)

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2016 (July 1, 2015–June 30, 2016).

Courses Delivered


- 23 courses were delivered in September, bringing the fiscal yearto-date total to 75
- 22 courses were offered at NJCSI sites; 1 was offered at an off-site location



Training Days



- 25 training days were delivered in September, bringing the fiscal yearto-date total to 85
- 24 training days were delivered at NJCSI sites;
 1 training day was delivered at an off-site location




Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)

- 498 duplicated participants attended courses in September, bringing the fiscal yearto-date total to 1,651
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.



Training Participants (Unique Participants)


- 456 unique participants attended courses in September, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 1,428
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants.
 Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.



Courses Delivered by Type

 Courses delivered in September included 20 foundation courses, 2 elective courses, and 1 outreach course (Employer Services Training delivered by teleconference).



Duplicated Participants by Course Type


- In September, 412

 participants attended
 foundation courses, 42
 attended elective courses,
 and 44 completed a WBT.
- To date, 1,267 participants have attended foundation courses, 9 have attended specialized courses, 256 have attended elective courses, and 119 have completed a WBT.





Duplicated Participants by Agency



- 54% of the September trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 270), and approximately 20% were from the Family Division (n = 100)
- From July through September, 49% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 812), and approximately 21% were from the Family Division (n = 340).
