- Foundation, specialized, and elective training opportunities are offered year-round at three state-of-the-art sites in Parsippany, Princeton, and Cherry Hill.




Introduction (continued)

- Technical assistance is offered at off-site and remote locations, and distance learning is offered through the Internet.
- Fiscal year-to-date data refer to fiscal year 2017 (July 1, 2016–June 30, 2017).



Courses Delivered


- 34 courses were delivered in February, bringing the fiscal year-todate total to 184
- All courses were offered at NJCSI sites.





Training Days


- 37 training days were delivered in February, bringing the fiscal year-todate total to 234
- All training days were delivered at NJCSI sites.





Training Participants (Duplicated Participants)


- 2,152 duplicated
 participants attended
 courses in February,
 bringing the fiscal year-to date total to 9,289
- Duplicated participants represent participants counted more than once, based on their participation in more than one class session.





Training Participants (Unique Participants)


- 2,104 unique participants attended courses in February, bringing the fiscal year-to-date total to 8,487
- Unique participants refer to the actual count of individual participants.
 Attendees were counted only once, whether they attended a one-day training session or multiday training sessions.





Courses Delivered by Type


 Courses delivered in February included 30 specialized courses, 3 foundation courses, and 1 elective course.






Duplicated Participants by Course Type

- In February, 431 participants attended specialized courses, 35 attended foundation courses, 14 attended the elective course, and 1,672 completed a WBT.
- To date, 893 participants have attended foundation courses, 1,601 have attended specialized courses, 495 have attended elective courses, and 6,300 have completed a WBT.





Duplicated Participants by Agency



- Approximately 70.2% of the February trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 1,511), and approximately 14.9% were from the Family Division (n = 320).
- From July through February, approximately 54.8% of the trainees were from PCSE Units (n = 5,095), and approximately 20.3% were from the Family Division (n = 1,883).
