Flint Kids Book was created by high school student Olivia Holden. The Flint Kids Book is a children's book designed to improve literacy rates for children in Flint, Michigan. As of 2017, reading proficiency for children in Flint was as low as 10.7%, according to the Michigan Department of Education. Using imagery and phrases specifically tailored towards empowering children in Flint, the Flint Kids Book aims to better motivate Flint Kids to read more. The Flint Center for Health Equity Solutions of the Michigan State University, College of Human Medicine, Division of Public Health is raising funds to distribute the book locally and are currently at over \$2,000 of the \$5,000 goal set. The book's creator, Olivia Holden, is a Health Equity Research Scholar at the Flint Center for Health Equity Solutions through the Michigan State University College of Human Medicine under the SURE MatCH Group's very own Dr. Debra Furr-Holden.
