The individual's Wager Score and subsequent notifications are intended to help them gamble responsibly and within their financial means. This study, among young adult sports gamblers, seeks to understand how or if use of this affordability tool translates to changes in gambling behavior, as well as the gambling-related cognitions experienced during play.
