What is an Age-Friendly Community?

Age-friendly refers to how community features support the health and well-being of residents as they experience long lives. Age-friendly communities provide safe, walkable streets, affordable and accessible housing and transportation options, access to needed services, and opportunities for residents of all ages to participate in community life.

What is the Age-Friendly New Jersey Statewide Collaborative?

The Age-Friendly New Jersey Statewide Collaborative is a group of New Jersey organizations and leaders working to promote state and local policies and practices that support long, healthy lives. It will initiate a statewide coordinated effort that will advance age-friendly state policies and accelerate the local implementation of policies and programs that support long lives. The Age-Friendly New Jersey Statewide Collaborative includes:

- ➤ **The Steering Committee**: a multi-sector group focused on coordinating and supporting the work of the collaborative, including setting high-level strategic direction and policies that guide the overall collaborative.
- ➤ The Local Accelerator Sub-Committee: a multi-sector group focused on identify, connecting, and advancing ways to accelerate local action and implementation support long lives in communities across New Jersey
- ➤ **The State Policy Sub-Committee**: a multi-sector group focused on identifying, prioritizing, and developing state advocacy strategies, policy, and practices that embed a person-centered and placebased approach to aging within and across a broad range of issues and sectors.

How Can the Collaborative Foster the Creation of Age-friendly Communities?

Like many communities around the country and the world, New Jersey's demographics are shifting towards a population that is living longer. Currently at 23% of the population, by 2030 NJ's residents over the age of 60 will outnumber students in our schools. The time to prepare is now; and creating age-friendly places in a manner that results in long-term, systemic change requires deliberative processes and methods. Thoughtful collaboration and partnership are critical to organizing complex systems across disciplines at both state and local levels; while understanding that state and local policy and implementation are two distinct, but complementary components. This collaborative will create synergies across various sectors by:

- > Encouraging the State of New Jersey to be more age-friendly in policies and engagement.
- > Integrating an age-friendly perspective into state and local decision-making.
- > Expanding the implementation of local actions that create age-friendly places and systems.
- > Mobilizing and connecting community members and leaders engaged in age-friendly community building.
- > Changing perceptions and conversations to reflect the inherent value of people as we age.
