### Membership with the Rutgers Hub for Aging Collaboration

Hub members include faculty, staff, postdoctoral associates, and graduate students at Rutgers who are advancing scholarship that contributes to the Hub mission to change social contexts for aging and health equity. Membership is layered onto individuals' primary organizational roles at Rutgers (e.g., Associate Professor, Graduate Assistant, Research Project Coordinator).

There are two categories for faculty membership in the Hub: Core Members (for SSW faculty) and Affiliate Members (faculty outside SSW). Staff are also eligible for an Affiliate membership.

In consultation with the Hub Steering Committee (consisting of core faculty and staff), as necessary, the Director of the Hub will lead in determining whether an individual's membership as part of the Hub is consistent with the criteria.

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### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

### CORE

#### **Hub Core Member**

Rutgers School of Social Work (SSW) faculty or staff member whose scholarship focuses on aging, health/disabilities in middle and later life, and/or adult development

#### **AFFILIATE** Hub Affiliate Faculty Member

Rutgers faculty member outside of the SSW whose primary focus of scholarship contributes to the Hub mission on changing social contexts for aging and health equity

#### **Hub Affiliate Staff Member**

Rutgers staff (directors and specialists) outside of the SSW whose primary focus of scholarship or professional leadership contributes to the Hub mission on changing social contexts for aging and health equity

#### **POSTDOC**

#### **Hub Postdoctoral Member**

Rutgers SSW Postdoctoral Associate whose scholarship primarily focuses on aging, health/disabilities in middle and later life, and/or adult development

#### **STUDENT**

#### Hub Student Member

Rutgers SSW students who are formally dedicated to Hub-funded projects (e.g., as a Graduate Assistant), works with a Hub core member on Hub-related activities, and/or a SSW graduate student whose dissertation will contribute to the Hub mission on changing social contexts for aging and health equity
