Practicum Requirements – CSW and MAP

All students are required to complete a total of 1,125 hours. The Generalist Practicum I & II require 15 weeks of 15 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters. The Specialized Practicum III & IV require 15 weeks of 22.5 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters.

* **Appropriate Practice and Practicum courses must be taken during the same semester.**

*** **You may choose additional Advanced Practice Distribution Requirements and/or Advanced Contemporary Policy Requirements to satisfy general elective requirements.**
