### Practicum Learning Requirements - CSE and MAP

All students are required to complete a total of 675 hours.

Practicums III & IV require 15 weeks of 22.5 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters.

## MSW CURRICULUM ADVANCED STANDING PROGRAM

### LISTA CERTIFICATE

LISTA may be taken by students in either the Clinical or MAP Concentration.

There are four courses required for the LISTA Certificate. **These three are required:**

- [503]: Social Work with Latinos
- [549]: Latinos: Culture, Community, and Social Welfare
- [568]: Behavioral Health with Latinos (required for LISTA students in the Clinical Specialization)

**AND**

Advanced year practicum with an approved Latinx serving agency

You must choose from one of the following courses for your 4<sup>th</sup> choice (or 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> choices if MAP):
