### **Practicum Requirements – CSW and MAP**

All students are required to complete a total of 1,125 hours. The Generalist Practicum I & II require 15 weeks of 15 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters. The Specialized Practicum III & IV require 15 weeks of 22.5 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters.

\* **Appropriate Practice and Practicum courses must be taken during the same semester.**
