Practicum Learning Curricular Requirements

Students in the 100% Online Advanced Standing MSW program complete 675 hours of practicum during the program. The schedule for Fall start is:

Courses must be taken in the above sequence and practicum hours must be completed in the above sequence. Only after successful completion of the generalist courses, generalist practicum hours and the statistics requirement, can students begin the specialized curriculum. **Placements cannot be provided for evening and weekends only. It is the responsibility of the student to have the hours available to do the practicum. Monday –Friday during the business day (9-5).** There may be placements that offer some weekend and evening hours, but this cannot be guaranteed.

100% Online Advanced Standing Curriculum

The specialized curriculum consists of a specialization in a method of advanced clinical practice or management and policy, an advanced research course, advanced field instruction, and electives. Only after successful completion of the generalist courses and the statistics requirement can students begin the specialized curriculum.
