STATEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

My community-engaged addictions research targets solutions for rural and underserved populations by emphasizing and identifying treatment and policy recommendations, strategies to reduce barriers to care, and methods that promote health equity. I study opioid use disorder, other addictions, and comorbid behavioral health disorders. Having grown up in a rural, medically underserved, mental health professional shortage area of Michigan guides my scholarship and intention to promote trust with community partners. I have led and collaborated on projects funded by the United States Department of Health and Human Services (e.g., SAMHSA, HRSA), philanthropic foundations, and university funded research initiatives; have received awards from the National Institute on Drug Abuse, College on Problems of Drug Dependence, and U.S. Fulbright Program; and engage in service for scientific outlets, community health and social work organizations, and academic institutions. My refereed journal publications have applied multiple methods to interpret data from patients, providers, medical records, and public health measures. I teach and disseminate recommendations on addiction, behavioral health, and health equity for academic, practice, community, and policy audiences. My leadership development includes being the Co-Director and New Jersey Director of the Northeast & Caribbean Rural Opioid Technical Assistance Center (serving HHS Region 2 for SAMHSA's ROTA-R program) and being part of the Rutgers University Equity and Inclusion Identity and Leadership (I-LEAD) Program's inaugural cohort. Before joining the faculty at Rutgers University, I was at Wayne State University as a tenure-track faculty, and prior to that, as a postdoctoral fellow. I earned my PhD from Rutgers University, MSW from the University of Michigan, and BS from Miami (Ohio) University. My full-time faculty positions, and each educational institution I earned degrees from, have all been in social work programs at public research universities. Conversely, much of my training and collaborations involve academic partnerships with other disciplines (e.g., psychiatry, psychology, public health).
