## Practicum Learning Curricular Requirements

Practicum hours **must** be completed in the above sequence.

All 100% Online MSW students are required to complete 400 generalist hours (Practicums 1-3 at the same placement) and 500 advanced hours (Practicums 4-5 at a single advanced placement) for a total of 900 hours.

Placements cannot be provided for evenings and weekends only. It is the responsibility of the student to have the hours available to do the practicum, Monday –Friday during the business day (9 am-5 pm).
