Practicum Learning Curricular Requirements

Practicum hours must be completed in the above sequence.

All Blended MSW students are required to complete 400 generalist hours (Practicums 1- 3 at the same placement) and 500 advanced hours (Practicums 4-6 at a single advanced placement) for a total of 900 hours. Placements cannot be provided for evenings and weekends only. It is the responsibility of the student to have the hours available to do the practicum, Monday – Friday during the business day (9 am-5 pm).
