Practicum Learning Requirements - CSE and MAP

All students are required to complete a total of 675 hours.

Practicums III & IV require 15 weeks of 16.67 hours per week during the Fall **and** Spring semesters.

*Appropriate Practice and Practicum courses must be taken during the same semester.

*** You may choose additional Advanced Practice Distribution Requirement and/or Advanced Policy Requirement to satisfy general elective requirement.



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LISTA CERTIFICATE

LISTA may be taken by students in either the Clinical or MAP Concentration.

There are four courses required for the LISTA Certificate. **These three are required:**

- [533]: Latinos: Culture, Community, and Social Welfare
- [524]: Social Work with Latinos
- [529]: Behavioral Health with Latinos (required for LISTA students in the Clinical Specialization)

AND

Advanced year practicum with an approved Latinx serving agency

You must choose from one of the following courses for your 4th choice (or 3rd and 4th choices if MAP):
